
TRACS Tip of the Month

Create a Custom Filter for “My Projects”

On the right side of the TRACS mapper, click on the  arrow icon to open the Layer Manager dock and go to the “Filters” tab. All users start out with “Active Projects in My Groups” selected as their default filter.

To create a custom filter to view just your own projects on the mapper, select “New Filter” and give the filter a name (e.g. “My Projects”).

Go to the rules tab and select “Add Rule”. From the first box, select “User Created”, then select “is” and enter your name. Add another rule to find projects by “User Modified” as well. Tip: Select match “any” to find projects you created or modified. Then click 'Preview' to view a list of results before clicking "Save" and "Close".



Tip: Use the “Manage Filters” button to select your new filter as the default filter that will always appear when you open the mapper.
